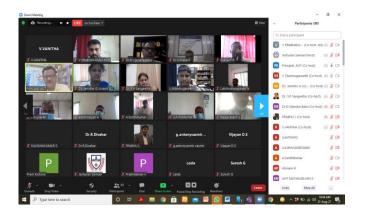


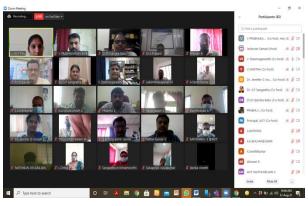


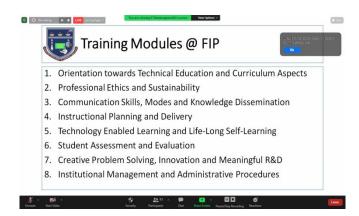


About the Webinar

Inference from the webinar

- 1. 1. This webinar focused on the need for NITTT MOOC courses with learning outcomes, Instructional strategies, Assessment.
- 2. 2. It focused on the scientific instructional procedures and assessment with context-based teaching rather than adopting the content-based teaching approach.
- 3. It also emphasized the previous initiatives of NITTTR, Training Policies which aimed to transform all the faculty members to be versatile and self-sustainable in content discussions.
- 4. It also elaborated on Faculty Induction Program [Phase-I, Phase-II & Phase-III] for inductee teachers and also on the In-service Training Programme (ITP) with the specific requirements at various levels of the teaching career.













- 5. It also briefed the process of FIP Phase-II. The inductee teacher is expected to work under a mentor at the institute and also discussed the various reforms he/she could adopt in FIP training.
- 6. It also elaborated on the Phase-III process of FIP in which the teacher is expected to spend 2-3 weeks as part of training in an industry/research lab for their effective training.
- 7. The resource person discussed In-service Training Levels [ITP Part-I & Part –II] ranging from Refresher module till the basic involved in education technology
- 8. He also emphasized all the modules of ITP from Essential Pedagogy till Accreditation and Ranking Framework with all the evaluation modes.
- 9. He emphasized Evaluation Rubrics and also on the Metrics involved in calculations.
- 10. He discussed problem-solving, Innovation and Meaningful R&D, and so on.
- 11. He enunciated the "Participant Registration" & "HIO registration" in the NITTT portal and the flowchart of the process flow.

The session was ended with a formal Vote of Thanks, delivered by Ms.Vanitha, Assistant Professor (G-II)/ECE, and Feedback also collected from all the participants for quality enhancement.
