


This program was overall coordinated by Mr.V.Prabhakaran, Assistant Professor (G-II)/BME – AVIT, Chennai.




EVENT BANNER

The Field trip was started at 7.30 AM from "AVIT", Chennai, towards the Hospital Visit at "Aarupadai Veedu Medical College (AVMC)". Initially the trip was started with general introduction about various biomedical devices and equipment and the students showed very good interest on the biomedical equipment's working and operating procedures.

Initially, as a start of the Visit, Mr.Thiyagarajan, Senior Biomedical Engineer, "Aarupadai Veedu Medical College (AVMC)" has demonstrated the working principle of "Biomedical Waste/Instrument Sterilization Unit" and also the procedures for inducing waste on to the machine for sterilization. He also elaborated on the Waste segregation, treatment of waste and various procedures involved in waste disposal. Further, he also explained about the various strategies involved in biomedical instruments sterilization which is the mandate for any medical instruments.


