A Report on National Science Day 2023

The National Science Day 2023 (NSD 2023) was celebrated successfully on 28th February 2023 in AVIT by the Department of Humanities and Science in association with the Institution's Innovation council and Tamil Nadu Science Forum, Chengalpattu District to mark the discovery of Raman Effect by Physicist Sir C. V. Raman.

The programme commenced with a Prayer Song. The Ceremonial Lamp was lighted by the dignitaries. Dr.Jeniffer G. Joseph, Head, H&S delivered the Welcome Address.


More than two hundred students participated enthusiastically in the celebration along with their respective faculty members of Humanities and Science. The students showed rapt attention in the inaugural function.
