They were also asked to participate in the "Sweet Symphony" event where the students were expected to prepare the traditional Tamilnadu sweet dish Kozhukattai in college. The students actively gathered mud from AVIT playground and sculpted the idol of Vinayagar. They adorned and decorated the statues with Indian dals like Urad dal, Toor dal, decorative shiny stones, gems, flowers, sandal powder, kungumam powder etc. Tables were set in the portico and all students arranged their idols on them. The students were allotted the Chemistry lab to cook Kozhukattai. With the help of induction stoves the students cooked the jaggery, coconut stuffing and they baked the Kozhukattai in electric rice cookers. They presented the scrumptious Kozhukattai along with the Vinayagar idols.
