Faculty Development Program in Paints and Coatings <u>Day 1- 25.07.2025</u>

The Departments of Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering at Aarupadai Veedu Institute of Technology (AVIT) jointly organized a Faculty Development Program (FDP) on "Paints and Coatings" on 25th July 2025 in the Digital Classroom, AVIT. This program was conducted in collaboration with the Paints and Coatings Skill Council.

About the Event

The first day of the FDP was successfully held from **9:30 AM to 5:00 PM**, highlighting engaging and insightful sessions by distinguished industry experts:

- Mr. Gowri Shankar Mahalingam, Advisor, Paints and Coatings Skill Council
- Mr. Joseph Gerald Paul, Paint Specialist

Both resource persons shared their extensive industrial experience and domain expertise, which enriched the learning experience of all participants. A total of 12 faculty members from the Departments of Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Chemistry of AVIT, as well as the Department of Chemistry from SAS, actively participated in the sessions.

The day's proceedings were divided into four interactive and knowledge-intensive sessions:

Session 1:

Introduction to the Paints and Coatings industry, sector overview, career opportunities, and progression pathways. An icebreaker activity was also conducted to engage participants.

Session 2:

Fundamentals of paint – types, classifications, surface preparation, and composition. The session offered a comprehensive understanding of paint systems based on resin type and end-use applications.

Session 3:

Hands-on group activity to compare various paint systems, surface types, and finishes. This session emphasized practical learning through collaboration and application.

Session 4:

Practical demonstration on identifying substrates and finishes, followed by an interactive Q&A session, which allowed participants to clarify doubts and deepen their technical understanding.

The event was hosted by Dr. R. Divahar, Professor and Head, Department of Civil Engineering, and coordinated by Dr. R. Abirami, Assistant Professor (G-II), Department of Civil Engineering. Day 1 of the FDP concluded on a highly positive note, with active participation, engaging discussions, and valuable takeaways. The program served as a strong platform for bridging academic knowledge with industrial practices, laying a solid foundation for the sessions to follow.
