

In celebration of Innovation and Creativity Day, the Institution Innovation Council (IIC) of Aarupadai Veedu Institute of Technology (AVIT) organized a guest lecture titled "Innovators: The Architects of Tomorrow". The event aimed to inspire students by showcasing the critical role innovators play in shaping the future across various sectors. The Program started with the welcome address by Dr B Prabasheela, Professor and IIC convener of AVIT. The session was led by Dr. Seenuvasan, District Program Manager at the Entrepreneurship Development and Innovation Institute (EDII), Chengalpattu. He began the lecture by providing a bird's eye view of how innovators are actively transforming key sectors such as healthcare, energy, technology, and social reform.

Dr. Seenuvasan uniquely illustrated the mindset of innovators using comedy videos, which made the session engaging, lively, and relatable for the students.
