Instead of cocooning students and discouraging exposure to the world of business, this priority integration of business schools would enable school students hailing from different socio-economic backgrounds to have an equal access to creative and out-of-the-box thinking, and taking a shot at entrepreneurship in the future. All learners feel equally empowered, and are encouraged to test their thoughts and interpersonal skills in a way that would eventually create a major economic stimulation. For instance, in the current system, perhaps one out of ten students would contemplate entrepreneurship at the middle-school level. However, if the development of an entrepreneurial mindset is made a part of the curriculum, then perhaps all ten would be inclined towards it. Eventually, there would be a much larger percentage of those who would actually go on to create economic opportunities for themselves and many others.
